

## Best Paper Award published in IJCIS in 2024

According to the agreement between EUSFLAT and Springer Nature, every year a Best Paper Award to acknowledge and honor the authors of an outstanding paper published in International Journal of Computational Intelligent Systems (IJCIS) will be granted. The winner will receive a Springer e-book voucher of EUR 500, a special mention in the Best Paper Award section on the journal website and an official award certificate.

A formal application must be sent by e-mail (with the subject: IJCIS best paper award) to the EUSFLAT President ([president@eusflat.org](mailto:president@eusflat.org)), the EUSFLAT board member in charge of publications ([rmrodrig@ujaen.es](mailto:rmrodrig@ujaen.es)) and the Editor in Chief of IJCIS ([martin@ujaen.es](mailto:martin@ujaen.es)) by **January 31, 2025**.

Applicants should have published the candidate paper for the award in IJCIS **between 1<sup>st</sup> January 2024 and 31<sup>st</sup> December 2024** and the **applicant must be member of EUSFLAT**.

Applicants should provide the following documents:

1. Published paper in a pdf file
2. A signed document by the applicant with the following information
  - Name, affiliation, address and e-mail of the applicant.
  - Title of the publication
  - DOI of the publication
  - Url of the publication
  - A short summary of the proposal that highlights its innovation and impact in the fuzzy community (it cannot be copied from the published Abstract)
  - EUSFLAT membership data
3. A document signed for all authors stating that they agree to participate in the application for the Best Paper Award 2024.

The winner of the Best Paper Award will be jointly selected by EUSFLAT President, EUSFLAT board member in charge of publications and Editor-in-Chief of IJCIS, based on their expert judgment of how these papers contribute scientifically to the journal's core priority areas.
