# 3. Treasury Report

The report has been presented by the EUSFLAT Treasurer, Prof. Jorge Casillas:

The Society now has 260 members from 26 countries

The surplus in the year 2008 was negative due to high Mathware & Soft Computing expenses. The reminder was positive.

In the year 2009, the number of copies of Mathware & Soft Computing will be reduced from 450 to 300. On the other side, it is planned to raise funds for students' grants. The surplus is expected to be near zero.

After its presentation, the Report of the treasurer is approved by the Assembly's assent.

# 4. Honorary Membership (extraordinary issue)

On behalf of the Board, *Prof. Ulrich Bodenhofer* proposes to nominate the first EUSFLAT President Prof. Francesc Esteva for honorary EUSFLAT member. Francesc Esteva is an outstanding researcher and one of the founders of the society. The Assembly approves the proposal.
